

Exit Interview Information for Carers

Thank you for the role you have played in caring for children and young people in care

As a carer, you have made a difference in the life of children and young people in care. Feedback from you will assist us to improve the experiences for new and existing carers and the way in which the Department for Child Protection (DCP) works with carers.

The exit interview is provided to kinship carers, foster carers and Specific Child Only (SCO) carers when they cease their caring role.

The information obtained in exit interviews will be de-identified and collated by the DCP. Feedback from carers about their caring experience will be used to inform future carer recruitment and retention strategies and improve the way we work together to provide information, support and training to carers.
