## Supporting Family Contact



**The Department for Child Protection (DCP) is responsible for making decisions about family contact. As a kinship carer, you have a significant role in helping make those decisions.**

DCP is committed to working in partnership with you to make sure you have the information and support you need.

This learning and development module will explain:

- ways in which you can help support positive family contact
- explore strategies to respond to children’s behaviour before and after family contact
- how to advocate for your child’s needs and raise any concerns that you may have
- how DCP makes assessments on what is considered in the best interests of the child.
